



Prohibited Items for All Traditional Halls

The following appliances and other items are prohibited in all traditional residences. These items are responsible for actual fires in college and university housing units throughout the United States.

Wall hangings made of burlap or other flammable materials, tapestries, fish netting, flags, and wicker ornaments. Combustible materials of any type are prohibited when attached to room ceilings. Cords may not be run under rugs or closet doors, nor secured to building surfaces or furniture	Any decorative lighting that is hung from the ceiling or is in contact with any combustible materials (e.g., tapestry, posters, pictures, etc).

Cooking is not allowed in residence halls or suite rooms, or in any other room except the kitchen.

The following appliances are approved for use in the kitchen area Cheshire Hall. Any Cheshire Hall resident who wishes to use one of the appliances listed below must meet with and gain approval by the Experience Director for Cheshire Hall prior to use. Approval is granted only if the appliance is Underwriters Lab (UL) listed and the unit is properly connected to the wall outlet. If approval is granted, the student must sign a contract agreeing to terms and conditions governing the use of the appliance.

Cooking is not allowed in any rooms except the kitchen.
