

Certification of Finances for International Students—Undergraduate Programs

This form must be completed by Franklin Pierce University applicants who are not United States citizens or permanent residents (resident aliens/green card holders). The purpose of this form is to certify that you will have the funds available for the 2019 – 2020 academic year at Franklin Pierce. A certificate of eligibility (Form I-20) for a student (F-1) visa will not be issued unless this form is completed and the necessary documents are provided. Proper documentation is essential to the issuance of an I-20 form and subsequent F-1 Visa required to enter the United States.

You should make copies of this form and required documents before submitting to Franklin Pierce, as you will need to show proof of adequate funding to U.S. Consular officials when applying for a visa.
