

Marlin Fitzwater Scholarship in Public Communication

Marlin Fitzwater Scholarships in the amount of \$2000.00 each, are awarded annually to ten matriculating freshmen. Students applying for this scholarship should demonstrate:

- Engagement in public communication through high school and/or community experiences in print and/or electronic media. This can include, but is not limited to, work in newspaper, radio, television/cable, literary magazines, the World Wide Web, or business, education, government or non-profit organizations, with roles as diverse as reporter/writer, editor, producer, talent, graphic artist, webmaster, public relations representative, press secretary/spokesperson, campaign strategist, or intern.
- Good academic performance in college preparatory courses.
- Supportive recommendations from a teacher, advisor or employer familiar with the student's achievements in public communication and potential for future contributions to the field.
- A desire to continue your study and practice of public communication at Franklin Pierce University.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, you must submit all of the following:

1. Complete the reverse side of this application and submit work samples (e.g.: newspaper articles, video, scripts, press releases, speeches, letters to the editor, advertisements, literary journals, etc.).
2. Write a one page essay discussing the role you have played in promoting public communication in your high school or community and how you will use that experience in promoting the study, management and/or practice of public communication at Franklin Pierce University.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor or employer attesting to your interest, expertise and/or contributions in the field of public communication. This recommendation should be from someone who has direct experience with your work in this field.
