Eric Jefferson received his Bachelor of Science degree in Recreation Management in 1993. Eric was a student leader who, by his involvement in the Franklin Pierce community through Student Senate activities, exemplified the mission of the University. He was a very active and popular campus member who always rallied his friends to reach higher, strive to do more, and enjoy life to the fullest. He served as vice president of the Student Senate and chairperson of Franklin Pierce's Association of Clubs and Organizations. Eric was on the Student Senate Executive Board and a member of the Student Alumni Council, the Law Club, and the Business Club. He also served as a Campus tour guide and chairperson for the Cultural Series.

Shortly after graduation, Eric became ill and passed away in 1998. In loving memory, his parents, family and friends established the Eric Jefferson Scholarship. The scholarship is awarded annually to a returning junior or senior who has demonstrated strong leadership with the Student Senate.
