**COVID-19 Testing Forms**

Dear students and families:

As you are aware, there is a COVID-19 test requirement for returning to campus. We have asked our students to provide a negative test result for a test administered no later than 72 hours prior to your scheduled move-in time (for residents) or the first day of classes (for commuters). Please refer to our [FAQ section](#) for additional details.

Recognizing that many students may not be able to access a testing turnaround that quickly, we will also have testing on campus August 16th through August 19th that will be done at either your scheduled move-in time, or for commuters, the time you schedule on those days via the links previously emailed to you.

**For students testing on campus, please review, complete and print the following documents to bring with you on your testing day:**
