***Important Academic Affairs Updates:
Please read before attending classes***

The first day of classes is almost here! As part of your preparations in these final hours, Academic Affairs has some information and updates to share with you.

Check Your Franklin Pierce Email Often

Make it a habit to check your FPU email regularly - at least once a day. Your faculty will be sending you important information, as will other offices on campus such as the Registrar, Student Financial Services, Center for Academic Excellence and Student Affairs.

First Class Meeting - Attendance Update

All students need to check each of your Canvas Course pages **BEFORE** going to class. Because of the need to spread desks further apart for social distancing, some classrooms are too small for all of the students enrolled to attend at the same time. Faculty have made plans to deal with this, which may entail meeting outside the classroom, or some students needing to view the course remotely some of the time.

Faculty have posted their plans on each class's Canvas page, generally under their "Introductory Statement". Be sure to check it out before heading to the classroom. You can [log in to Canvas](#) using your Franklin Pierce login and password to open your dashboard. Your courses will be listed there, and you can check the "Introductory Statement" for details. Many faculty are including this in their announcements as well as in other locations on the Canvas Course page. Your faculty may also be sending an email with details, so also check your FPU email account. If you are uncertain, you can always contact your faculty member(s) by email.

Logging in to Canvas

Forgot your password? Click 'Forgot Password', enter your username, and we'll send you a link to your email to change your password.

COVID Symptoms or COVID Positive Test

Should you experience COVID symptoms, please **DO NOT** attend class, and take the following steps:

- 1) Contact Student Health Services immediately.
- 2) Email your course faculty, and let them know that you will be joining class remotely until your situation has been resolved.
- 3) Attend class remotely using the information provided by your faculty in the Canvas Course "Introductory Statement".

Sanitizing Classroom Workspace

Students are asked to utilize the disinfecting products available in your classroom to disinfect your personal work surfaces (desk top, chair, etc.) when entering the classroom.
