Candidate for the Honorary Degree

Richard T. Griffiths

Doctor of Humane Letters

A media ethicist with more than 40 years of journalistic experience, Richard Griffiths' global impact on editorial integrity, free speech, and media access to government has exemplified his belief that independent journalism is essential to a working democracy, a value that is now more crucial than ever.

Originally from Britain, Mr. Griffiths began a lifelong career in journalism as a college radio reporter at University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He worked at several radio and television stations before becoming a producer for CBS News, where he took on many global assignments included reporting on South African apartheid, the fall of Baby Doc Duvalier in Haiti, and NASA's Space Shuttle program.

At CNN, Mr. Griffiths began producing documentaries before overseeing "The Row," the global network's editorial quality control operation for more than two decades. There, he covered the events of the Arab Spring and led the network's coverage of the September 11 terrorist attacks. His special reports contributed critical information to the public conversation on a phenomenally wide range of issues, including substandard care given to children in adult emergency rooms, the 1992 European Community deadline, the changing workplace, and the increasing tabloidization of US media. Additionally, he provided editorial oversight of CNN's investigative journalism and the network's fact-checking operations during the 2008, 2012, and 2016 presidential elections.

Beyond his extensive work in the media, Mr. Griffiths has consulted on and taught journalism ethics, investigative reporting, and editorial management throughout the country, including at Franklin Pierce University, and around the world. His work included travels to Australia, Jamaica, Indonesia, the Philippines, Switzerland, and Poland, and often places where freedom of the press is not the norm.

In recent years, Mr. Griffiths has focused on continuing education for local journalists as president emeritus of the Georgia First Amendment Foundation. He also continues to lecture on editorial ethics and media trust at University of Georgia and at the University of North Carolina.

Candidate for the Honorary Degree

Joyce Maynard

Doctor of Humane Letters

A prolific novelist, memoirist, and journalist for more than four decades, Joyce Maynard is renowned for upholding the truth and inspiring others to do the same.

A native of New Hampshire, Ms. Maynard began publishing her stories in magazines when she was just thirteen years old. She first came to national attention with the publication of her *New York Times* cover story, “An Eighteen-Year-Old Looks Back on Life”, in 1972, when she was a freshman at Yale University. Since then, she has been a reporter and columnist for *The New York Times*, a syndicated newspaper columnist whose “Domestic Affairs” column appeared in over fifty papers nationwide, a regular contributor to National Public Radio and national magazines including *Vogue*, and *The New York Times Magazine*. She is a longtime performer with The Moth. She is the author of eighteen books, including the *New York Times* bestselling novels, *Labor Day* and *To Die For* (both adapted for film), *Under the Influence* and the memoirs, *At Home in the World* and *The Best of Us*.

In addition to her many books, Ms. Maynard has authored book reviews and commentaries for *Mademoiselle* and *Harrowsmith*, wielding truth on topics ranging from racism to parenthood. In 1986, Ms. Maynard helped lead the opposition to constructing the nation’s first high-level nuclear waste dump in New Hampshire, a campaign she described in a *New York Times* cover story.

Ms. Maynard is the founder of Write by the Lake, a week-long workshop on the art and craft of memoir, held every year since 2001 at Lake Atitlan, Guatemala. This workshop helps countless people in the U.S. and abroad to become writers. Her bravery, energy, and passion for the truth have helped others face their own difficult truths.

Ms. Maynard’s latest novel, *Count the Ways* —the story of a marriage and a divorce, and the children who survived it— was published by William Morrow in July, 2021. She is currently at work on a book about her return to Yale University two and a half years ago as an undergraduate, forty-eight years after leaving at age 18.

The Honorable Walter R. Peterson *Citizen Leader Award*

The Honorable Walter R. Peterson Citizen Leader Award was created to honor the late Governor Peterson's lifelong commitment to public service and higher education in the state of New Hampshire. He served two terms as the Governor of New Hampshire and was Franklin Pierce University's second President from 1975-1995. He also was President Emeritus of the University until his passing in 2011. This award, presented at the annual Commencement Exercises, is intended to acknowledge and to honor an individual for his or her extraordinary commitment to public service, selfless contributions to higher education, sense of humor, and high moral character — all characteristics of the award's namesake.

2022 Citizen Leader Award Winner

James T. Brett

In 1996 Mr. Brett was appointed president and chief executive officer of The New England Council, the nation's oldest regional business association. The Council is an alliance of schools, hospitals, corporations, and other private organizations promoting economic growth and quality of life in the region. In this role, he has been a leading voice for public policy issues on health care, education, financial services, and sustainable energy throughout New England.

The New England Council's Higher Education Committee focuses on initiatives and policy advocacy aimed at expanding access to higher education, developing a high-skilled talent pipeline to meet regional employer needs, investing in research, and supporting students to achieve their educational aspirations.

A graduate of American University, with advanced degrees from Harvard and Suffolk University, Mr. Brett served for more than 15 years as a member of the Massachusetts House of Representatives, where he held an array of important leadership positions, earning formal honors on many occasions for outstanding public service.

Most recently, he was recently appointed by President Biden as the chair of the President's Committee for People with Intellectual Disabilities, a role he has served in previous administrations.

Academic Regalia

Caps and gowns are a link with the early universities of the Middle Ages. In a time when all students were clerics, the gown and its attached hood served the dual function of keeping the student warm in unheated buildings and of identifying the particular order to which he belonged.

Modern academic regalia in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code established in 1895. The gown is commonly black, differing slightly according to the level of the degree. The baccalaureate gown has long pointed sleeves and is worn closed. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed and is distinguished by its oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The doctoral gown also may be worn open or closed. It has long, bell-shaped sleeves and is paneled in velvet with three matching velvet bars on the sleeves. The velvet may be black or a color distinctive of the degree conferred: Ph.D., blue; M.D., green; etc. Trustees wear doctoral gowns.

Caps are usually of the mortarboard style and are retained on the head throughout all academic exercises except during prayer when the men should remove them. The tassel on the mortarboard cap may be black or of the color indicating the degree. The doctor's tassel is gold. The tassel is worn over the left front quarter of the cap once the degree has been awarded.

The hoods are satin lined with the colors of the institution which conferred the degree; Franklin Pierce hoods are crimson and gray satin. The color of the velvet border indicates the subject to which the degree pertains.
