If you have already completed an MSN degree at Franklin Pierce, you must be accepted into the MBA program before taking courses toward completion of the second degree. Once admitted, you must complete a minimum of 24 credits in the MBA curriculum to earn an MBA degree.

#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Completed graduate admission application

- · Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university

  • CGPA of 2.8 or greater on a 4.0 scale

- · All official transcripts from colleges or universities previously attended

#### M.S.N. Program

- Unencumbered current license to practice as a registered nurse issued by New Hampshire or another jurisdiction
- Outline of professional aspirations and how a M.S.N. will help you achieve them
- · Telephone interview with the nursing faculty

#### M.B.A. Program

- Outline of professional aspirations and how this M.B.A. will help you achieve them (250-500 words)
- · Competency in the areas of accounting, statistics, and computer skills
- Telephone interview with M.B.A. faculty
- Essay: Answer one of the four questions below.
  - · A time when you made a lasting impact on your organization
  - A major accomplishment
  - · A major setback you have faced
  - · A time when you exceeded expectations
- Explain not only what you did, but how you did it. What was the outcome? What was the response? Only describe experiences that have occurred within the last three years.
