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ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Completion of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution.

In addition, the following courses are recommended:

- Medical Terminology (1)
- Psychology (3)
- Genetics (3)
- Immunology (3)

Coursework must be recent (within the last 10 years). All prerequisite courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better and be completed prior to matriculation. Applicants must have a cumulative undergraduate science GPA of at least 3.0 and a cumulative undergraduate overall GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications are accepted only through the Central Application Service for Physician Assistants (CASPA) at https://caspa.liaisoncas.com. All applications must be verified by December 1 for the following year and will be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.

All applicants are required to complete Casper as part of their application. To complete these assessments please visit www.AcuityInsights.app, create an account and register to complete the following assessments: Casper: 90-110 minute online, open-response situational judgment test. Your application will not be deemed eligible for review until we receive your Casper Assessment score.

Applications will be reviewed and ranked for consideration of an invitation for an interview. No entrance examinations are required for admission to the program. Faculty will review otherwise qualified applications when there are two or fewer outstanding prerequisites.

Applications will be ranked by considering the following:

GPA, personal statement, reference letters, clinical experiences, and other experiences to include:

- shadowing
- volunteerism
- research/teaching/publications
- achievements/leadership/challenges
- experience with rural and/or underserved communities and/or socioeconomically disadvantaged populations
