Service Animal in University Housing

Service Animals which will reside in University housing must be registered with Residential Life. Residential Life encourages owner of Services Animals to also register with the Office of Student Accessibility Services within the Center of Academic Excellence. A student intending to reside in university housing with a Service Animal must:

- Complete the following form
- Provide a copy of required documentation including the following to Residential Life:
 - o Veterinary materials (vaccination and certificate of health)
 - o Proof of Town of Rindge license (Dog Only)

Emotional Support Animals (ESA) in University Housing

Students requesting an ESA reside with them in their on-campus assignment must obtain approval from the Office of Student Accessibility Services by following the steps below. ESAs may not be brought into university housing without prior approval from the Office of Student Accessibility Services. A student intending to reside in university housing with an ESA must:

Once approved for the accommodation:

- Complete the following form.
- Provide a copy of required documentation including the following to Residential Life:
 - Veterinary materials (vaccination and certificate of health)

Please Note:

- There is a 40-pound maximum weight limit for ESAs.
- > Out of consideration to both students and ESAs, a maximum of one (1) ESA is allowed per bedroom on campus.
