

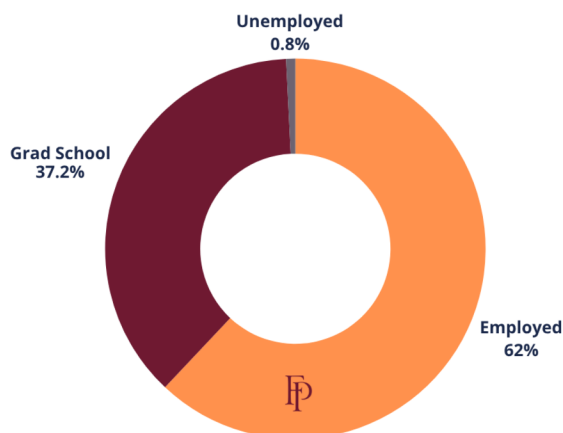

Data collected through Handshake and analyzed by the Office of Career Education in the Lloyd & Helen Ament Astmann '69 Career Center Data collection is focused on first destinations within the first 6 months of graduating.

First Destination summaries are based on the Knowledge Rate of graduate outcomes six months after graduation according to the guidelines for undergraduate outcomes data collection and reporting [National Association of Colleges and Employers \(NACE\)](#). Knowledge Rate, defined by NACE, includes direct survey responses and basic employment or graduate school information confirmed through LinkedIn, employer reports, and faculty.
